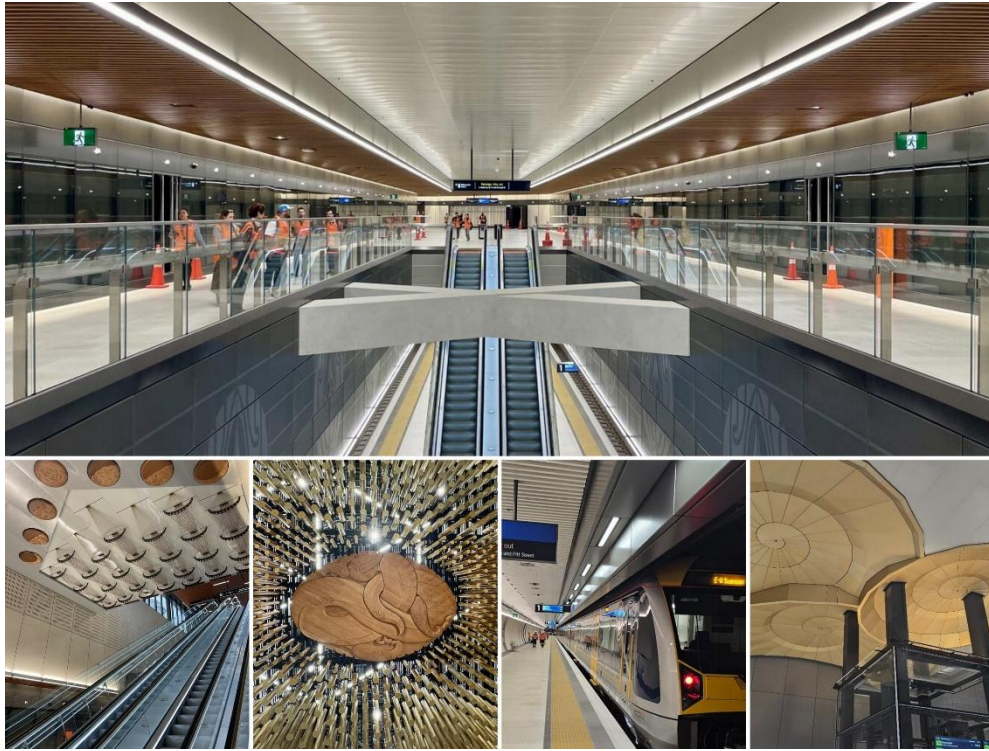




Auckland Transport has confirmed more details about the plans for City Rail Link opening

First look station visits

To mark the occasion, three free 'First Look at the Station' events will be held, giving Aucklanders the chance to experience the new stations, before CRL starts operating. These will be on three successive Saturdays, at each of the three new stations. Tickets will be made available in advance, and visitors allocated 1 hour slots throughout the day.

CRL Day 1

Opening day for CRL will be Sunday and it will be announced with 6 weeks notice, which allows the final countdown to begin. This time will also enable Aucklanders to get ready for changes to their travel options. There will be opportunities for eager enthusiasts to get involved on Day 1. There will be no formal ceremonial event.

First 100 days

After CRL opens, a wider programme of events and activations will be led by other Council agencies to encourage people to visit and check out the city centre - using CRL where possible. Customer ambassadors to be deployed to help support the public navigate the new network.
