How can I get elected to the Board?	You can stand for election only if you are a full member of WQ TMA
	• You must give your consent and complete an application form which has
	been signed by two other members of WQ TMA
	• Return date for nomination forms is 5pm Wednesday 15 th November 2023

How can I become a member of WQ TMA?	not eligible to nominate, stand for election or vote at the AGM
How call become a member of wQ TWA!	 To become a full member you need to be operating within the boundary of WQ TMA area. A boundary map is on our website along with the

	 You must complete an application form and pay an annual membership fee
What is the term of the Board members?	 An Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held each year and at that time
what is the term of the board memoris.	vacant seats are usually open to all members
	 Those elected will serve for one year or until the next AGM
	• The seat belongs to the business/employer rather than to any individual
How will the election take place?	• Nominations must be sent in on the completed application form
	• The closing date for applications is Wednesday 15th November 2023 at
	5pm
	 If there are insufficient nominations to fill all vacant seats, those who have
	applied will be automatically selected to the Board. The remaining vacant
	seats will become casual vacancies
	• If the number of nominations is equal to the number of vacant seats, the
	persons nominated will be deemed to be elected
	 If the number of nominations exceeds the vacancies, then a poll will be
	conducted at the AGM on Thursday 23 rd November 2023
	• The election process is covered in Section 15 of the Constitution
When is the closing date for nominations?	• The closing date, after which no further applications for the vacant seats
	on the Board will be received is 5pm Wednesday 15 th November 2023
