How many seats are on the Board?	There are 11 voting seats on the Board
	The non-voting representatives on the Board are Auckland Transport,
	Auckland Urban Development office and Waitemata Local Board

What will I need to do as a Board member?	You will need to attend monthly Board meetings and other meetings which
	may arise from time to time
	You will agree to abide by the WQ TMA Constitution, this can be viewed on
	our website
	You will agree to work, as far as possible, collaboratively with the whole
	Board for the benefit of WQ TMA
How can I get elected to the Board?	You can only stand for election if you are a full member of WQ TMA
	You must give your consent and complete an application form which has
	been signed by two other members of WQ TMA
	 Return date for nomination forms is 5pm Thursday 20th November 2025
	Associate members (those who operate outside the boundary area) are
	not eligible to nominate, stand for election or vote at the AGM
How can I become a member of WQ TMA?	To become a full member you need to be operating within the boundary of
	WQ TMA area. A boundary map is on our website along with the
	membership application form
	You must complete an application form and pay an annual membership fee
What is the term of the Board members?	An Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held each year and at that time
	vacant seats are usually open to all members
	Those elected will serve for one year or until the next AGM
	The seat belongs to the business/employer rather than to any individual
How will the election take place?	Nominations must be sent in on the completed application form
	The closing date for applications is Thursday 20th November 2025 at 5pm
	If there are insufficient nominations to fill all vacant seats, those who have
	applied will be automatically selected to the Board. The remaining vacant
	seats will become casual vacancies
	If the number of nominations is equal to the number of vacant seats, the
	persons nominated will be deemed to be elected
	If the number of nominations exceeds the vacancies, then a poll will be
	conducted at the AGM on Wednesday 3rd December 2025
	The election process is covered in Section 15 of the Constitution which can

When is the closing date for nominations?	The closing date, after which no further applications for the vacant seats
	on the Board will be received is 5pm Thursday 20th November 2025
