

Election to the Board of WQ TMA – Fact Sheet

Wynyard Quarter Transport Management Association is seeking Board members.

What will the Board do?	• The Board of WQ TMA will manage and control the affairs of the Incorporated Society • The Board will work together to implement an agreed Business Plan • The TMA will not be setting policies or making decisions that are the responsibility of Auckland Council or Auckland Transport • WQ TMA Board will work with and for its members and advocate for change when appropriate
How many seats are on the Board?	• There are 11 voting seats on the Board • The non-voting representatives on the Board are Auckland Transport, Auckland Urban Development office and Waitemata Local Board
What rules govern the Board and the TMA?	• The Constitution that governs WQ TMA and Board were submitted to the Companies Office and can be viewed on our website
What will I need to do as a Board member?	• You will need to attend monthly Board meetings and other meetings which may arise from time to time • You will agree to abide by the WQ TMA Constitution • You will agree to work, as far as possible, collaboratively with the whole Board for the benefit of WQ TMA
How can I get elected to the Board?	• You can only stand for election if you are a full member of WQ TMA • You must give your consent and complete an application form which has been signed by two other members of WQ TMA • Return date for nomination forms is 5pm Wednesday 11th November 2026 • Associate members (those who operate outside the boundary area) are not eligible to nominate, stand for election or vote at the AGM
How can I become a member of WQ TMA?	• To become a full member you need to be operating within the boundary of WQ TMA area. A boundary map is on our website along with the membership application form • You must complete an application form and pay an annual membership fee
What is the term of the Board members?	• An Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held each year and at that time vacant seats are usually open to all members • Those elected will serve for one year or until the next AGM • The seat belongs to the business/employer rather than to any individual
How will the election take place?	• Nominations must be sent in on the completed application form • The closing date for applications is 5pm Wednesday 11th November 2026 • If there are insufficient nominations to fill all vacant seats, those who have applied will be automatically selected to the Board. The remaining vacant seats will become casual vacancies • If the number of nominations is equal to the number of vacant seats, the persons nominated will be deemed to be elected • If the number of nominations exceeds the vacancies, then a poll will be conducted at the AGM on Wednesday 25th November 2026 • The election process is covered in Section 15 of the TMA Constitution which can be viewed here
When is the closing date for nominations?	• The closing date, after which no further applications for the vacant seats on the WQ TMA Board will be 5pm Wednesday 11th November 2026
